Today's Program;

David Wilkinson, Founder & Past President of the Woodland Tree Foundation. David is the Author of two books about Woodland's local architecture 'Crafting a Valley Jewel' and Urban Forestry 'Gertrude's Oaks'. The Woodland Tree foundation started in the year 2000 with three primary goals:

- To Educate residents, local government, schools, local businesses and others in the community about the health, economic, and environmental benefits of a healthy tree canopy in Woodland
- . To Plant and care for trees to beautify and cool Woodland streets and public spaces
- To Partner with the City, community groups, schools, businesses and individuals to stretch dollars and other resources on behalf of trees

Over the past 24 years the Tree Foundation has planted and cared for over 6,000 trees with major planting efforts along highway 113, downtown Woodland and school properties, with a focus on restoring Woodland to its native oak landscape. In 2020, a huge effort was made to map all the Valley Oaks in Woodland with trunks greater than 40 inches in diameter. The foundation has no paid employees or board members. Volunteers participate by planting trees and watering them for the first three years. More information can be found at woodlandtree.org
